



CALVARY

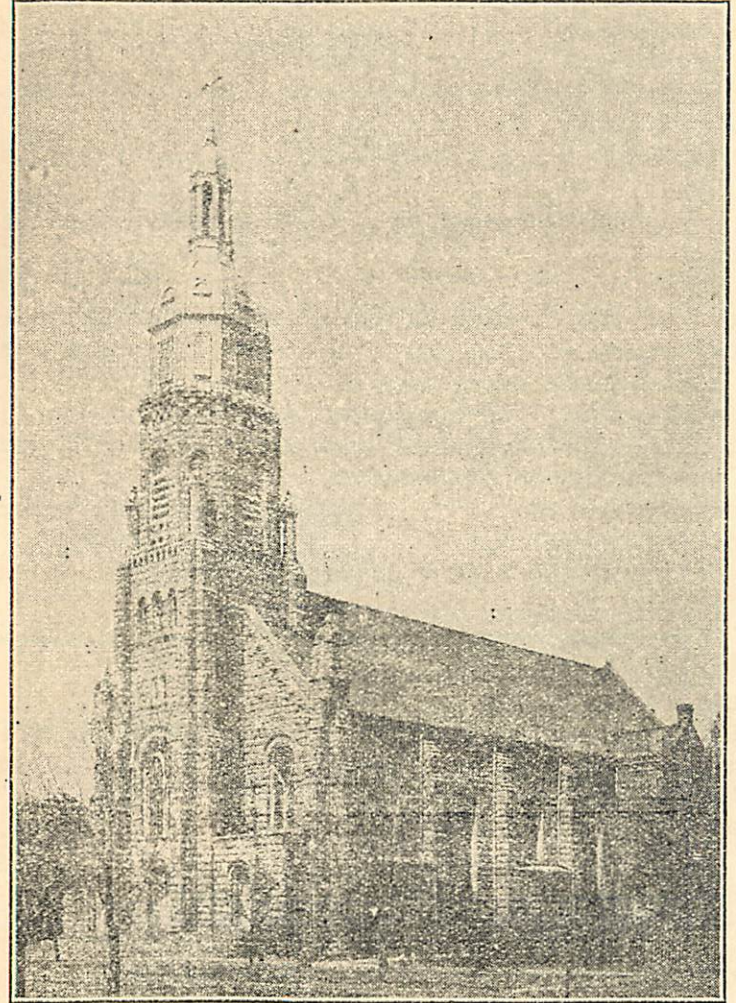
Come thou with me,
