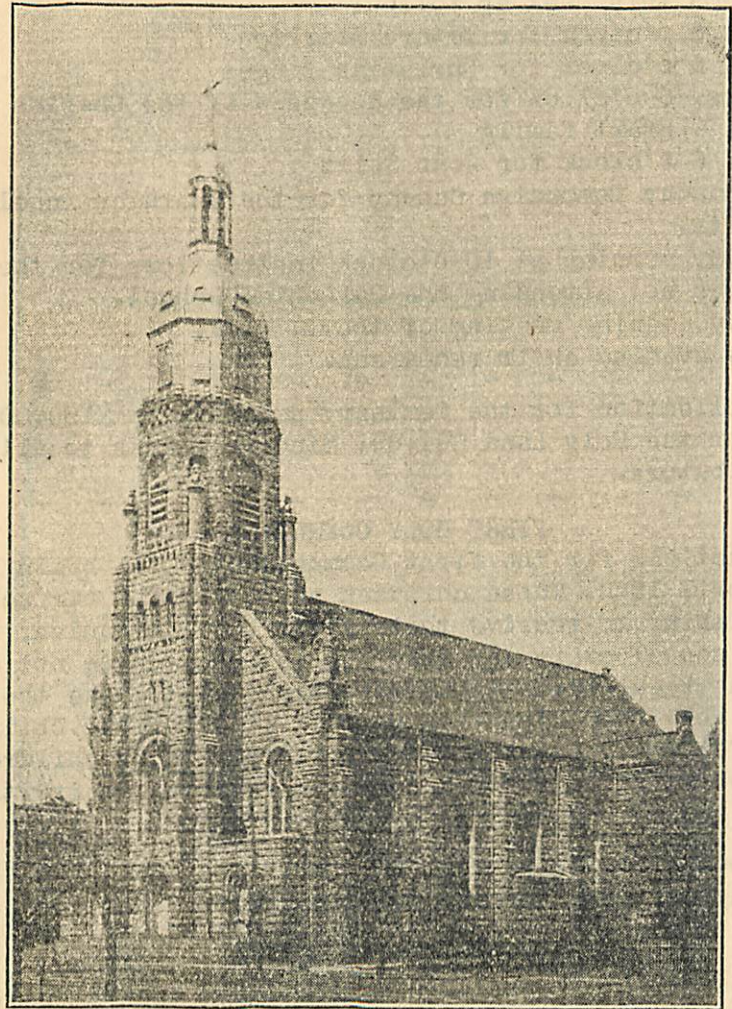


A PRAYER HYMN
