

Ausserordentliches Jubilaeum fuer das Jahr 1929.

Tief geruehrt von den vielen Huldigungen welche ihm zu seinem goldenen Priesterjubilaeum dargebracht wurden, hat der Hl. Vater, Papst Pius XI., ein ausserordentliches Jubilaeum fuer die ganze Kirche ausgeschrieben, um so allen Glaebigen Anteil zu gewahren an seiner eigenen Freude.

Das ausserordentliches Jubilaeum begann am 6 Januar 1929 und dauert bis zum 31 Dezember 1929. Wer die nachstehenden Bedingungen erfuehlt, kann jedesmal, sooft er alle wiederholt hat, einen vollkommenen Ablass fuer sich oder fuer die armen Seelen gewinnen.

Die Bedingungen sind folgende:

1. Wuerdiger Empfang der hl. Beicht und der hl. Kommunion.

2. 6 Besuche zur Pfarrkirche. Bei diesen Besuchen muss man muendliches Gebet nach der Meinung des Heiligen Vaters verrichten, fuer die Bekehrung der Suender, fuer die Ausrottung des Irrglaubens, fuer Friede und Eintracht unter Fuersten, so dass die heilige Kirche ueberall Fortschritte machen koenne. Doch muss man nicht ausdruecklich an diese Meinungen denken. Es genuegt einfach fuer die Meinungen des Hl. Vaters zu beten. Fuenf Vater Unser und Fuenf Gegruesst Seist Du Maria oder ein anderes Gebet von gleicher Laenge ist hinreichend.

(Die Besuche koennen an verschiedenen Orten derselben Dioezese und in verschiedenen Dioezesen in den bestimmten Kirchen gemacht werden.)

3. An zwei Tagen, die nicht schon Fast und Abstinenz Tage sind muss man Fasten mit Abstinenz halten.

4. Nach dem Rate des Beichtvaters soll man ein seinen Verhaeltnissen entsprechendes Almosen einem frommen Werke zukommen lassen; insbesondere dem Werke der Glaubensverbreitung oder dem Werke der Erhaltung des Glaubens. Dieses Almosen muss man nicht in der Kirche geben in welcher man die Besuche gemacht hat.

GOD'S DUES

"He that is counted in the number from twenty years and upwards, shall give the price". Exodus 20:14.

Holy Scripture itself gives ample proof that God expects dues from the young people also.

"All tithes of the land, whether of corn, or of the fruits of the trees, are the Lord's, and are sanctified to Him. And if any man will redeem his tithes, he shall the fifth part of them. Of all the tithes of oxen and sheep, and goats, that pass under the shepherd's rod, every tenth that cometh shall be sanctified to the Lord. It shall not be chosen, neither good nor bad, neither shall it be changed for another. If any man change it: both that which was changed, and that for which it was changed, shall be sanctified to the Lord, and shall not be redeemed. THESE ARE THE PRECEPTS WHICH THE LORD COMMANDED MOSES." Lev. 25:11-20-99.

Our Lord came to fulfill the Law and prophets. We ac-

cept the moral law given on Mount Sinai. We must not SET UP OUR OWN STANDARD, but conduct ourselves according to THE STANDARD SET BY THE LORD. We are to be judged according to that law. The law of "first-fruits and tithing" was also given to us by the same God. Are we at liberty to set up OUR OWN STANDARD IN THIS IMPORTANT MATTER? dare you, without sin, give to God and His Church WHAT YOU WANT or must you not give WHAT HE SETS DOWN AS YOUR SHARE? According to the Holy Bible, will you be judged by YOUR STANDARD or GOD'S?

The lesson that God comes first, was impressed over and over upon the conscience of the Israelites. How many people think FIRST of God? Your NECESSARY EXPENSES come FIRST---no one will criticize you for that ---but when luxuries and amusements come before God and His Church, such conduct cannot bring blessings. The reason for the poverty of many may perhaps be due to their smallness to God. Do you remember the words of Holy Scripture: "Give, and it shall be given to you."

The story is told of Father Sorin, the founder of Notre Dame, that when in 1879 a fire destroyed all his buildings and money was sorely needed, he nevertheless sent the first monecy that came in a check of \$1000.00 to the Foreign Mission House in Paris to have Masses said. His faith in God's generosity was not misplaced.

Were you ever made poorer by what you gave to God and His holy church?
