



PASTOR'S NOTES

Sacrosanctum,

The Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy, Vatican II, Series, Part 2.

Fr. Brian Lager

"2. For the liturgy, "through which the work of our redemption is accomplished," [1] most of all in the divine sacrifice of the Eucharist, is the outstanding means whereby the faithful may express in their lives, and manifest to others, the mystery of Christ and the real nature of the true Church. It is of the essence of the Church that she be both human and divine, visible and yet invisibly equipped, eager to act and yet intent on contemplation, present in this world and yet not at home in it; and she is all these things in such wise that in her the human is directed and subordinated to the divine, the visible likewise to the invisible, action to contemplation, and this present world to that city yet to come, which we seek [2]. While the liturgy daily builds up those who are within into a holy temple of the Lord, into a dwelling place for God in the Spirit [3], to the mature measure of the fullness of Christ [4], at the same time it marvelously strengthens their power to preach Christ, and thus shows forth the Church to those who are outside as a sign lifted up among the nations [5] under which the scattered children of God may be gathered together [6], until there is one sheepfold and one shepherd [7]." (Sacrosanctum Concilium #2)

The Liturgy is the public worship of the faithful within the Church. The Church is made up of not just us here on earth (the Church Militant), but also those in purgatory (the Church Suffering), as well as all in Heaven, angels and saints (the Church Triumphant). When the liturgy is celebrated all become present in what we call the Mystical Body of Christ, Christ is the head we are its members. Thus in the Liturgy the "real nature of the true Church." This means that Heaven is made present on earth. The human is brought in contact with the divine, the elements of the Liturgy are to give witness to the Divine present and so the visible gives way to the invisible.

In the Liturgy we act in order to contemplate. Our entire lives are meant to give way to contemplation of the heavenly realities. This is why we work to spend time in prayer and live to align our lives according to the Liturgy, so that we become living witnesses to the reality of our worship. By living the reality of the Liturgy in our life we begin to fulfill the call of the great commission to "go forth and make disciples." The Liturgy sends us forth to proclaim what we have witnessed and bring hope to people in despair and light to those in darkness. We are meant to bring others to know God so that we all may be gathered together in the Mystical Body of Christ.
