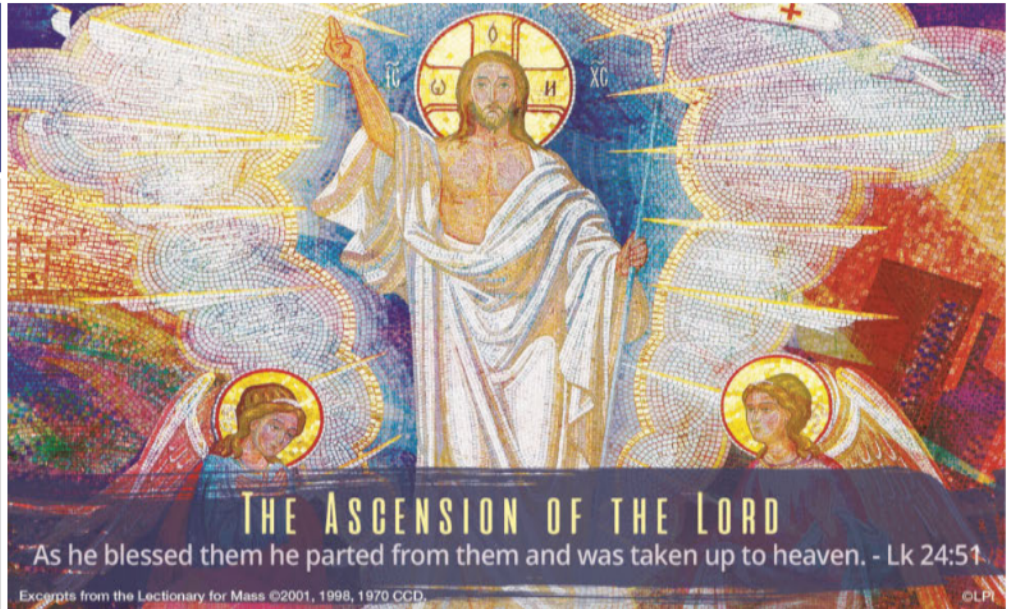

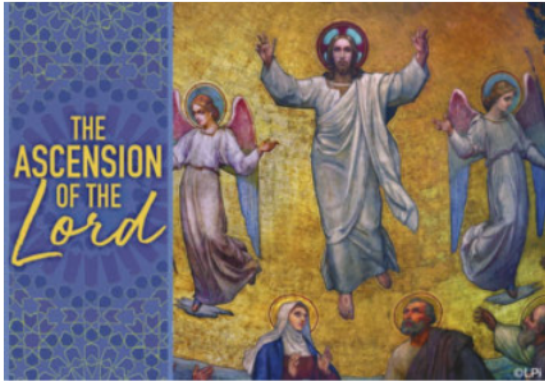
MASS TIMES.....

Pastoral Council feels that it would be good to keep our parishioners informed of the creation of the new cemetery, so what this bulletin and we will give you updates as the project progresses.

- ♦ The parking lot, one section and the road around that section have been developed. This section will allow 110 double lots or 220 single lot burials, The cost of the lots at the new cemetery will be the same as the current St. Joseph Cemetery. The developed area will be seeded this summer and lots in the new cemetery are projected to be available for sale in the Spring of 2023.

SAINTS



St. Joan of Arc | May 30

St. Joan of Arc (1412 – 1431) has had her story told throughout history through many books, movies and plays. She was born in the village of Domrémy, near the province of Lorraine, to a French peasant family. At a young age, she began to experience visions and voices, which were later identified to be of St. Michael, St. Catherine of Alexandria, and St. Margaret of Antioch. At the age of 13, all three saints told her that she was to drive the English from French territory, and that she must bring the Dauphin to

Reims for his coronation. Trusting in God, she did as she was told.

During the Hundred Years War, St. Joan of Arc led French troops against the English and recaptured the cities of Orléans and Troyes. Captured near Compiègne the following year, she was sold to the English and placed on trial for heresy and witchcraft, eventually being found guilty and burned at the stake in Rouen.

St. Joan of Arc was canonized by Pope Benedict XV on May 16, 1920, and is the patron saint of military members.
